WHY WORKPLACE GIVING

Workplace giving engages employees and has a positive impact on the community. There is a direct correlation with higher levels of employee engagement, on-the-job motivation, sense of contribution, and advocacy. Higher employee engagement has been shown to drive successful business outcomes, as reported by Workplace Giving Australia.

A workplace giving program with Carbon Positive Australia could help to bring your organisation's environmental, social, and governance (ESG) values to life and help your staff to find a greater purpose while contributing to the environment.

Workplace giving is a simple way for employees to make pre-tax donations via payroll, offset their carbon emissions, and plant trees. It is a way for your employees to go beyond carbon neutral and not only be carbon positive but bring positivity into the workplace.

WORKPLACE GIVING OPTIONS

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Workplace giving is a simple way for employees to regularly donate to a charity of their choosing. Employees technically receive the same salary for their company but donate a portion of every pay to their nominated charity.

The employer forwards the employees donations to the charity and the employee is still the one making the donation to the charity.

Lastly the employee can claim a deduction for their donation to the charity in their yearly tax return.

The amount of the employee's gross salary remains the same. In most cases, the donation amount is a fixed amount that the employer deducts from the employee's pay each pay day.





The employer then chooses to either:

- Reduce the amount of tax deducted from the employee's pay each pay period to account for the donation (and the employee can still claim a tax deduction in their tax return) or;
- Not to reduce the amount of tax withheld from the employee each pay period (the employee claims tax deduction for the amount donated at the end of the financial year)

MATCHED GIVING

Matched giving gives the employee the chance to boost their fundraising when the employee matches the donation they are making. Some organisations offer this on a dollar-fordollar basis where others prefer to specify the amount they are preferred to give.
